HMMC is committed to strategically developing its production capacities in order to maintain high quality, flexibility, and competitiveness in the long term, with an emphasis on optimizing operating costs.

1 Optimize production

In order to increase production efficiency, quality, and safety, HMMC will gradually expand the share of automated production lines. This step will strengthen the company's ability to respond flexibly to changing market demands while ensuring the stability of production processes.

2 Continue EV transformation

As part of its electromobility development, HMMC plans to produce three purely electric car models by 2030. At the same time, it will introduce a new EV platform, thereby optimally aligning production operations, quality control, and logistics with the planned expansion of its electric vehicle product portfolio.

3 Deliver high-quality products

HMMC will focus on strengthening quality management systems, particularly for key components, control units, and software elements of electric vehicles. The implementation of a digitized quality management system will enable continuous improvement of production parameters and increased customer satisfaction.

4 Accelerate digital transformation

As part of the "Software Defined Factory" concept, HMMC will develop the use of artificial intelligence and business intelligence for advanced data processing. The digitization of internal processes and data-driven decision support will contribute to accelerating innovation cycles, increasing operational efficiency, and better predicting production needs.

Today, the automotive industry faces environmental challenges that arise mainly from increasingly stringent legislation aimed at mitigating the effects of climate change, growing customer pressure for sustainability, and the ever more urgent need to protect natural resources for future generations. For HMMC, responsible management of environmental impacts is therefore a strategic priority, contributing not only to mitigating climate change but also to reducing environmental impacts.

1 Decarbonize

HMMC is committed to actively reducing greenhouse gas emissions across the entire spectrum of its activities in the long term. Its strategic approach to decarbonization is based on:

- increasing the company's energy efficiency, particularly by modernizing production technologies and equipment
- electrifying the company's vehicle fleet
- transitioning to renewable energy sources
- introducing a systematic energy management system within the company's own operations (ISO 50001).

The company is also striving to gradually decarbonize its value chain by producing low-emission vehicles and reducing direct emissions in its supply chain.

- *Between 2027 and 2029, 80% of average electricity consumption will be covered by Virtual Power Purchase Agreements (vPPAs). The remaining part will be secured by own electricity production from renewable sources and the purchase of guarantees of origin.*



- *By 2030, 70% of the company's vehicle fleet will consist of electric cars.*
- *Reduction of emissions from direct parts suppliers by at least 10% compared to 2019.*

*Note: Suppliers managed by the parent company are excluded from this target.
Reduction target refers to direct emissions and indirect energy emissions of suppliers (Scope 1 & 2).*

2 Move towards a circular economy

HMMC sees the principles of the circular economy as a key tool for reducing the environmental footprint of production and strengthening sustainability across the entire value chain. The company will continue to work systematically to minimize the amount of waste generated by its own processes. The priority is to find alternative ways of waste management that promote recycling and reuse. In this area, we will focus on the development and implementation of sustainable packaging solutions in cooperation with our suppliers.

HMMC considers water to be a key natural resource, the careful use of which is an important aspect of environmental responsibility and operational efficiency. The company actively implements projects focused on water conservation, particularly in production technologies.



- *In the period 2025-2029, reduce the average amount of mixed waste sent to landfill by 35% compared to the average for 2020-2024, from 4.35 kg to 2.77 kg per vehicle produced*
- *Reduce average water consumption by 4.6% between 2025 and 2029 compared to the average for 2020-2024, from 1.31 m³ to 1.25 m³ per vehicle produced.*

3 Promote biodiversity

HMMC considers the protection of biological diversity to be an important pillar of its environmental strategy. Biodiversity is the key to the stability of ecosystems and quality of life in the region.

The company participates in local projects focused on restoring natural habitats, planting greenery, protecting species diversity, and raising environmental awareness. These activities contribute to strengthening biodiversity in the region and creating value for local communities.

HMMC strives to more accurately identify the impacts of its activities on biodiversity across the entire value chain in order to better understand the impact of production and logistics processes on the natural environment and subsequently work systematically to mitigate them.

1 **Secure supply chain stability**

2 **Regulatory compliance**

Special attention will be paid to the use of harmful substances in production processes, with the aim of introducing suitable alternative solutions.

3 **Strengthen cybersecurity**

In response to the growing extent of digitalization, HMMC is committed to implementing advanced cybersecurity standards. The measures will focus on protecting production and information systems from growing cyber threats, with the aim of ensuring operational continuity, data protection, and the trust of partners and customers.

4 **Foster partnership with key stakeholders**

The company will deepen cooperation with key partners and share best practices with them. In the area of social responsibility, HMMC is committed to supporting local communities through grant programs, Hyundai fund activities, and volunteer initiatives.



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
